



**Art Fair Display
(with many extras) \$950.00**

It is hard to believe that this display has been used since 1992. It is in excellent condition because we have always taken care of it, loading and unloading it from the van and during set-up and tear-down. NOTE: All plywood, except as noted, is 1/2" finished (smooth) plywood. All black areas are painted with marine paint.

A Adjustable base: Comes with screw-on attachable feet to change height off the ground. Finished size is 49-1/2" square, including 2-3/4" x nominal 1" stained oak trim

B 1/4" Stained Plywood Panels: Fit into slots on the side of each short column, except at the back of display, which is curtained. This space provides for hidden, extra storage within the display.

C Short Columns, one at each corner: Including oak trim, these are 30" high and 14-1/4" square. During set-up, all four columns are bolted to the adjustable base to provide rigidity. All four have one door, key-locked, with three containing shelves and one clear for additional storage.

D Mid-Table: This sits on the four short columns and, like the base, is 49-1/2" square, including 1-3/4" x nominal 1" stained oak trim. Two holes in each corner for bolts, as described in the next section.

E Tall Columns with Two Sides Open, one at each corner of the table: Including oak trim, these are 48" high and 14-1/4" square. Three translucent white, acrylic shelves can be added, as needed, and are adjustable. Bolts can be dropped into two holes, at each corner, that go through Mid-Table and tops of Short Columns. When wingnuts are screwed on, these makes the tall columns rigid as well as the entire structure.

F Removable, recessed fluorescent fixture, one at each corner: When electricity is used, each column has an added, recessed, 9" fluorescent fixture at the top. These are plugged into receptacles, as shown in another photo.

G Solid Oak Cornice Boards: Nominal 1' x 6" Cornice Boards bolt into tops of Tall Columns to make the entire unit extremely stable.

H Electrical Skirt Board: Nominal 1" x 4" stained pine Electric Skirt boards hide the electrical connections on top of display.

I Five Halogen Accent Lights: One light above each tall column to provide accent and one to highlight the "show piece" on the center column. Still using the original bulbs but an extra set is included.

J Center Column: Barely shown, this is 12-1/2" high and 17-1/2" square. It is black with oak trim and has a translucent, white acrylic top and a 9" round fluorescent fixture. It is ideal for displaying a "show piece."

K Screws: There are two screws on some of the solid sides of the tall columns to hang 2-dimensional pieces, artist's statement, etc.

L Carpet: This black, gray, and white striped carpet has served me well to accent my display. It shows no wear and only requires vacuuming. It is 10' x 10-1/2'. (My art fair neighbors have always accommodated that extra half-foot, or it works well at a corner.) **Also included:** Many extras, plus we have used a number of second-hand Holiday Inn quilted bedspreads to place between the display parts in the van. They work well for padding and also help with sliding parts in and out.
